**III. Biographical notes:****1956–1959**

Attends private studio of painter Fricis Aleksandrs Zandbergs (1910–1972) together with a friend and classmate Aleksandrs Junkers Junior (1943–1998).

**1961–1973**

Intermittently worked different odd jobs: park maintenance, book distribution expeditor, power cable inspector, night guard, etc.

**Early 1960s**

Since 1962, frequents the Riga café nicknamed *Kaza* (Goat), where his contemporaries are Juris Veitners, Juris Zvīrgzdiņš, Māra Kimele, Andrejs Ģērmanis, Pirts Andersons, Biruta Delle, Huberts Delle, Augustīns Delle, Imants Reinholds, Māris and Maija Pauzers, Maija Tabaka, Aivars and Sarmīte Neibarts,

Zaiga Cērpa-Skrastiņa, Māra Meijere, Mudīte Gaiševska and many others.

#### **November 1963–December 1966**

Mandatory military service in the Soviet Army. He was sent to the most distant locations such as Azerbaijan. From there, Tifentals corresponded with Māra Ķimele, Māris Pauzers, Imants Reinholds, Huberts Delle, Zaiga Cērpa-Skrastiņa and other peers.

#### **1967**

Returns to Riga. His new friendships include Laima Eglīte, Juris Baklāns, Vija Maldupe, Ansis Rūtentāls, Guntars Pupa, Arnolds Plaudis, Baiba Puzina.

Meets photographer and artist Zenta Dzividzinska.

#### **1968**

December: marriage to Zenta Dzividzinska.

#### **Early 1970s—1998**

Moves from Riga to Jelcava where he lives together with Dzividzinska in her parents' house.

#### **1985**

*Pears with a Mountain in Background*, his last known finished work, is dated 1985.
